- zrhadsoua 10. Always dispose of  waste like used motor oil, antifreeze, cleaners and paints properly.

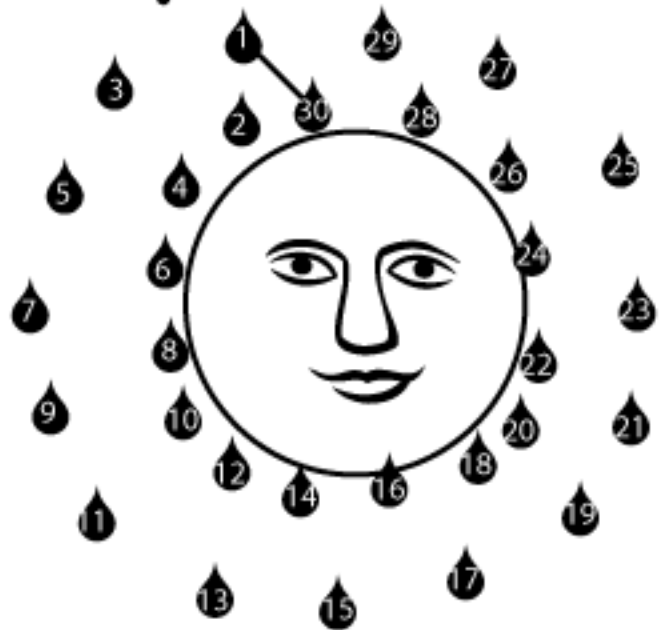

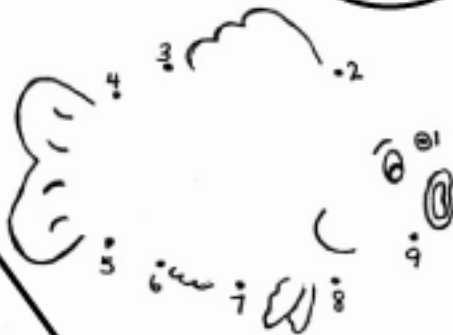
The Water Cycle



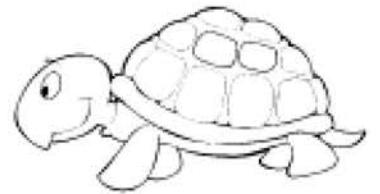
- A - evaporation

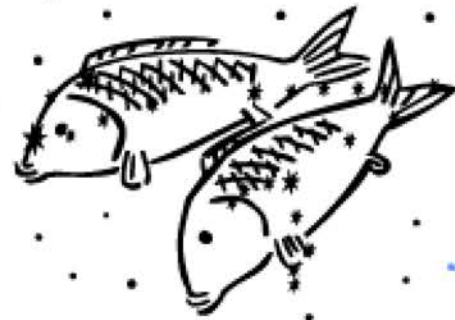

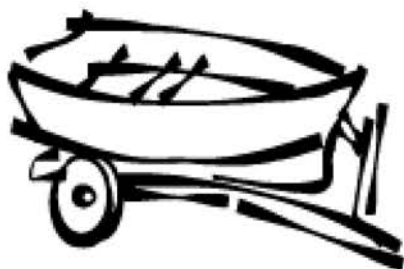

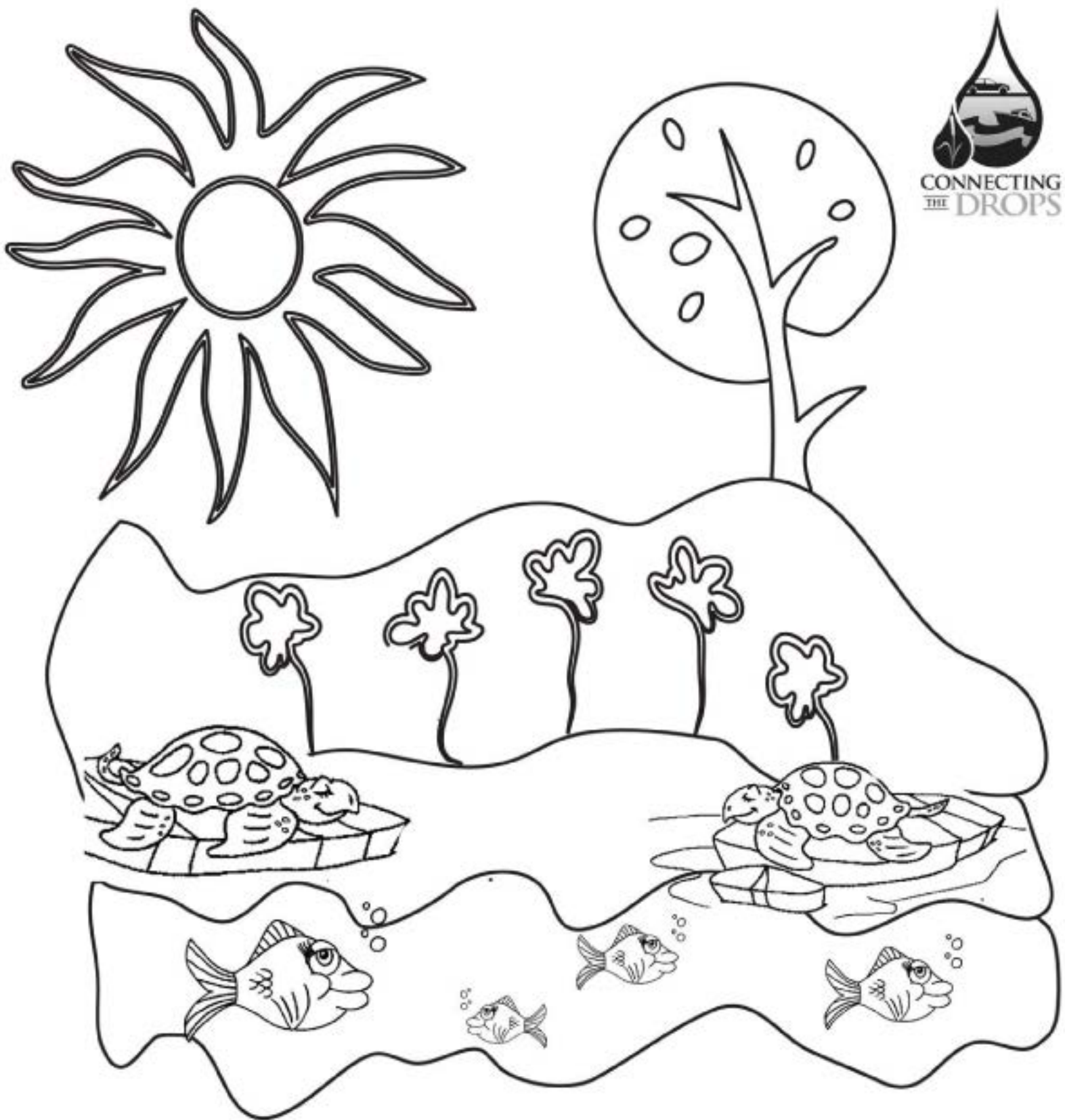
