REVISED RESTRICTIONS

<u>I-95</u>	(I-95) Between Interchanges 16 to 17 (Northbound Only)-No vehicles over 12'6" wide.
<u>I-287</u>	(I-287/95) No vehicles over 80,000 lbs between I-287, Exit 12 to I-95 North and the CT state line effective 1/7/19.
<u>I-87</u>	I-87 Interchange 16, Harriman-No vehicles over 11' wide (Northbound Exit) (I-87) Interchange 18 (New Paltz)-No vehicles over 11' wide (Entry) (I-87) Interchange 21B (Coxsackie)-No vehicles over 10' wide (Entry/Exit) effective 9/3/19 (I-87) Interchange 22 (Selkirk)-No vehicles over 10' wide (Entry/Exit) effective 9/3/19
<u>I-90</u>	(I-90) Between Interchanges 21A and B1 (Castleton-On-Hudson Bridge) - No New Special Hauling Travel Allowed over 80,000 lbs. (I-90) Between Interchanges 54 (West Seneca) and 55 (Lackawanna Toll Barrier) – No Vehicles over 10' 6" wide and 100' in length effective immediately, until further notice (Both Directions).
<u>I-190</u>	(I-190) Interchange 7 (Route 5 West - Skyway) - Southbound Only – Effective Immediately, Interchange 7 SB RAMP closed to all traffic, until further notice, due to construction activities (Entry/Exit).
