



# KEY FACTS

- SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT of Thruway bridges are MORE THAN 60 YEARS OLD
- EIGHTY-FIVE PERCENT of the sub-base dates back to the ORIGINAL CONSTRUCTION of the highway.
- MORE THAN 90 PERCENT of revenue comes from tolls.
- It has been 14 YEARS since the LAST SYSTEM-WIDE INCREASE for NY E-ZPass customers.

# TOLLADJUSTMENT PROCESS

- DECEMBER 2022: Thruway Authority Board of Directors approval to begin the adjustment process
- > JANUARY 2023: Proposed rule-making published in the State Register
- MAY & JUNE 2023: Five public hearings held Cheektowaga, Syracuse, West Nyack, Glenmont and Virtual
- Total of 210 public comments received
- Completed the Environmental Assessment for the Proposed Toll Modification
- Completed all necessary actions as required by Public Authorities Law, the State Administrative Procedure Act (SAPA) and the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA)





### TOLL SCHEDULE

#### SYSTEMWIDE (EXCLUDING GOV. MARIO M. CUOMO BRIDGE)

5% increase to NY E-ZPass rates on January 1, 2024 and January 1, 2027

#### GOV. MARIO M. CUOMO BRIDGE (GMMCB)

- Beginning January 1, 2024, NY E-ZPass passenger rate increases \$0.50 annually from 2024-2027.
- Continues GMMCB Commuter Discount Plan (40% Discount)
- Continues the Westchester and Rockland Resident Discount Plan and increases the discount from 17% to 20%.
- Commercial toll rates will increase annually from 2024-2027 by amounts proportionate to the passenger rate increases.


Beginning January 1, 2024, Tolls by Mail and Non-NY E-ZPass rates increase to a 75% differential above NY E-ZPass rate
