

# Malden Turnpike Bridge Replacement

*Town of Saugerties, Ulster County*



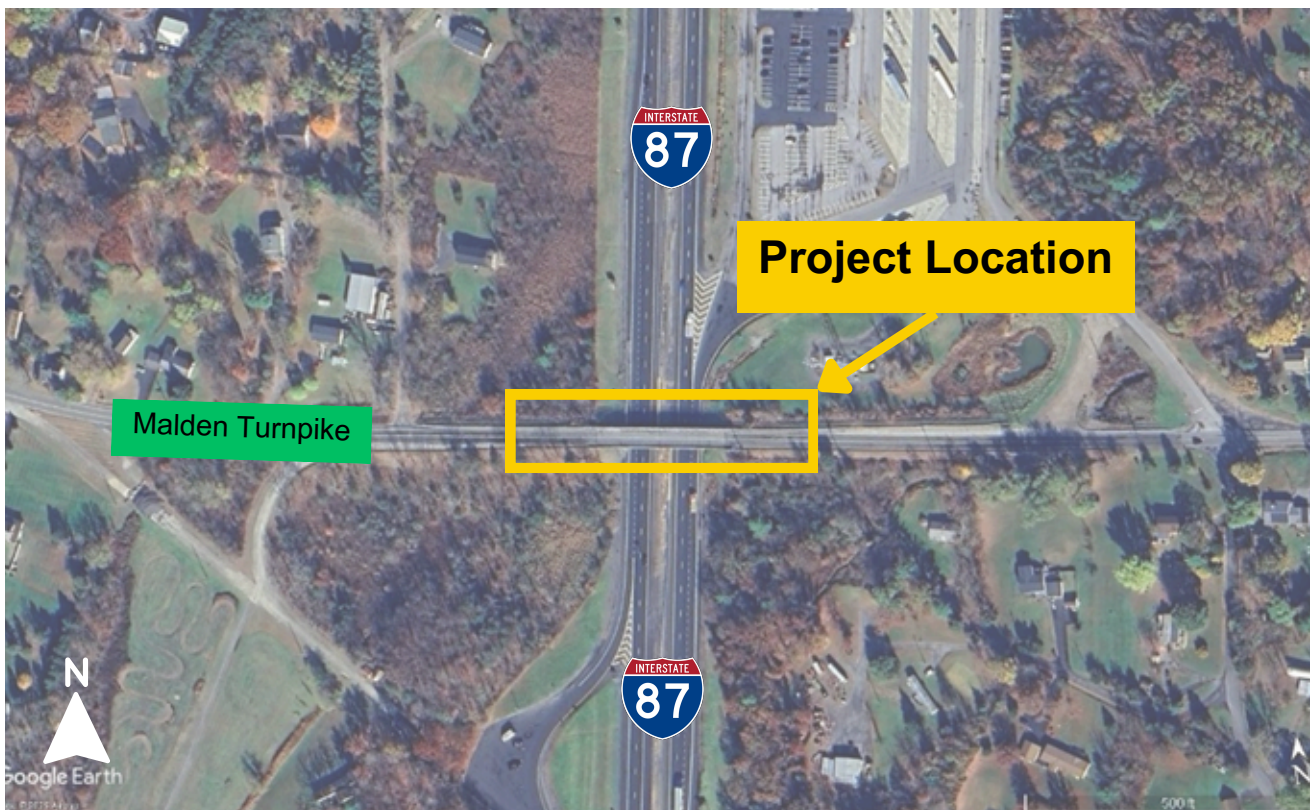

## **Project Information**

The existing bridge, built in 1948, carries Malden Turnpike over the Thruway in the Town of Saugerties. The bridge is at the end of its service life and will be replaced with a new structure that meets current standards. The proposed bridge will be designed for a service life of 75 years and accommodate two 11-foot travel lanes, with 5-foot shoulders. The project will upgrade roadway features such as vertical clearance, bridge railing, and it will improve the riding surface.

Throughout the project, traffic will be diverted using a signed detour route which would make use of State and County roads including NYS Route 32, NYS Route 212, and US Route 9W. The proposed detour route is nearly 7 miles long and is expected to be in place while the new bridge is being built.

Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2026 and is anticipated to be completed fall 2026.



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
