North Main St. (NYS Route 46) Bridge Replacement Project



City of Oneida, Madison County

Project Information

The existing bridge, built in 1954, carries North Main Street (Route 46) over the Thruway in the City of Oneida. The bridge is at the end of its service life and will be replaced with a new structure that meets current standards. The proposed bridge will be designed for a service life of 75 years and accommodate two 12-foot travel lanes, and widening shoulders to 8-feet. The project will upgrade roadway features such as increasing vertical clearance over the Thruway, new bridge railing, and it will improve the riding surface.

Throughout the project, traffic will be diverted using a signed detour route which would make use of State roads including NYS Route 31, NYS Route 365, and NYS Route 5. The proposed detour route is slightly more than 14 miles long and is expected to be in place while the new bridge is being built.

Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2026 and is anticipated to be completed fall 2026.
